 - Top 8 from Jr. classes inverted for pursuit

- Sign Ins closed at 9 am - Late entrants will be lined up at the back of the heat race
- No morning practice sessions
- Handler's meeting at 10.00 am
- Racing Immediately following Handler's meeting
- Welcome Cookout / Pot Luck following feature races - Hamburgers, Hot Dogs, Brats around 6 pm

 - o Donations accepted

Sunday, June 29th

- No morning practice sessions; Handlers Meeting at 10:00 am
- Racing begins at 10:30 am
- Award Presentation after all feature races are completed



Points

Points accumulate over 2 days of racing. Top 3 finishers in each class for the 2-day event will receive trophies. (except Novice)

- 1st place = 1 point
- 2nd place = 2 points
- 3rd place = 3 points

Lowest point total is the winner.

In the event of a tie - The tie breaker will be determined by the driver with the better finish on the second day of racing.

Participation award to all drivers.

Pre-registration Encouraged as participation award will be given to all drivers.

General Racing Info

- Parking will be directed by NWOQMRA - No parking before Friday morning
- Fuel **WILL NOT** be supplied - The club gas station is the Speedway at the corner of Dussel and Reynolds roads. Octane rating will be the same as the Region 4 Championship Series.
- All QMA rules will be in effect
- Motors will be sealed on Saturday. If you only race on Sunday you must get your motor sealed that day.
- If you need anything changed on a sealed motor see the Tech Director first.
- QMA code of conduct will be in effect; Must complete insurance waiver forms
- There will be NO bikes, scooters, motorized scooters, roller blades, roller skates, or golf carts allowed on the racetrack grounds. The host club will have the authority to confiscate these items during the event and will return them after the event is complete or the person or persons is leaving the premises.
- Race order will be:



- Jr. Novice; Sr. Novice; Briggs; Jr. Honda; Sr. Honda; Hvy. Honda; Lt. 160; Hvy. 160
- Heat races and transfer races format

- Race Laps will be:
 - Jr. Classes - Heats 15; Xfers 20; Mains 25
 - Sr. and other classes - Heats 20; Xfers 30; Mains 40
 - Hvy. Honda (Saturday) and Hvy. 160 (Sunday) will run extra lap features
- No timed warm ups prior to race - flagman discretion of a few warm up laps
- NWOQMRA reserves the right to modify this format
- **The NWOQMRA club race format will be used for anything not covered in this format.**

There will be prizes raffled off all weekend. This is a fun event to honor the memory of a great young man that raced in Region 4. Come out, have fun, race, and support a good cause.

From the East or West using I 80/90 (Ohio Turnpike) - Exit at Route 20 - Reynolds Rd then south to Dussel Drive east
